Building for the Future

Dear Parent,

This child care facility participates in the Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP). This program is sponsored by Solano Family and Children's Services, administered by the State Department of Education, and federally funded by the United States Department of Agriculture, (USDA).

As participants on the CACFP, both your child and his or her provider benefit! Your child's provider receives ongoing training on the nutritional needs of children of all ages with technical assistance at her fingertips. Well-nourished children are sick less often, learn more effectively, and behave better.

Your child benefits by receiving nutritional meals that meet the requirements of the USDA. Foods will be served from the four basic food groups: milk, protein, bread, and fruits/vegetables. Depending on the time your child attends, the provider will be reimbursed for up to two main meals and one snack or one main meal and two snacks per child per day. The guidelines for meals are as follows:

Breakfast

Milk
Fruit or Vegetable or 100% juice
Cereal or bread/alternate

Lunch /Dinner

Milk
Meat or meat alternate
1 Vegetable and 1 Fruit
Bread or bread alternate

Snacks

Two choices
from the
four food
groups

If you are a parent of an infant, your provider is **required** to offer an iron-fortified infant formula that meets the requirements of the guidelines in which she has been trained. If you refuse the offered formula or are providing breast milk, your provider can still be reimbursed as long as your provider is supplying the other components as they are introduced into your infant's meal pattern.

The ultimate purpose of this program is to instill healthy eating habits that will hopefully last a lifetime. It plays a vital role in improving the quality of child care and making it more affordable.
