
IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT TAXES FOR PARENTS AND PROVIDERS

NOTE: This Employment & Income Tax Process does not apply to PARENTS/GUARDIANS who choose Licensed Child Care Centers or Family Child Care Homes as their providers.

EMPLOYMENT TAXES:

- If you, the PARENT/GUARDIAN, choose child care in your home (in-home care), you are the employer and are responsible for Social Security tax and State Worker's Compensation Insurance. You may also be responsible for unemployment taxes.
- The PARENT/GUARDIAN is exempt from any EMPLOYMENT TAXES described above if the provider is the mother or father of the parent enrolled on the Subsidized Child Care Program.

INCOME TAXES:

- The PARENT/GUARDIAN is not required to withhold federal or state income taxes from the child care provider's earnings.
- The PROVIDER is responsible for reporting income and payment of any federal or state income taxes.
- SFCS reports provider payments to the IRS, State Franchise Tax Board, and Employment Development Department. In January of each year, all providers earning a minimum of \$600 in the prior year will be mailed a 1099 Misc. Report by SFCS.
